W.S. 22-4-114. Representation by proxy; qualifications. A member of a political committee or subcommittee may be represented at any meeting of the committee or subcommittee by written proxy. A person holding a proxy must be a resident of the same political subdivision as the member he [or she] represents. No person shall be allowed more than two (2) proxies.

WDP Bylaws, Section 4: Members of the Democratic State Central Committee may deputize, by signed proxy, substitutes to act for them at any meeting of the Democratic State Central Committee, but any such substitutes must be registered Democrats residing in the counties which their principals represent. Any member may vote his own and one additional proxy from the same precinct. A proxy holder who is not a member shall have only one vote and shall not be entitled to vote other proxies.
